DRESS REHEARSAL AND RECITAL: Makeup

Why Makeup? Makeup is meant to highlight the student's features and prevents the dancers from looking "washed out" under the stage lighting. We understand that some parents/guardians are not comfortable with the idea of children wearing makeup and we hope you see this as a part of their costume and experience similar to Halloween, where dressing up is often accompanied by face paint or make up to enhance the character.

Recommended (Optional) Stage Makeup Femme Look: Standard stage makeup is foundation, brown eyeshadow, black mascara, pink or nude blush & rose or red lipstick based on age.

Recommended (Optional) Stage Makeup Masc Look: Standard stage makeup is foundation, brown eyeshadow in the crease of the eye only, mascara, nude blush, nude lipstick.

Femme Makeup Application: Preschool to Kindergarten

Eyes: White or cream eyeshadow close to the lashes and the brow bone under the eyebrow
Brown eyeshadow on the eyelid, blended up to the crease
Black mascara

Cheeks: Light to medium pink or rose tones
Start at the hairline and sweep forward under cheek bone and swirl upward over apples
Blend upwards to make sure the blush does not go lower than the lip line on the cheek

Lips: Light to medium pink or rose colour
Use a lip liner to outline lips then fill in the entire lip to help keep lipstick on longer
Apply lipstick

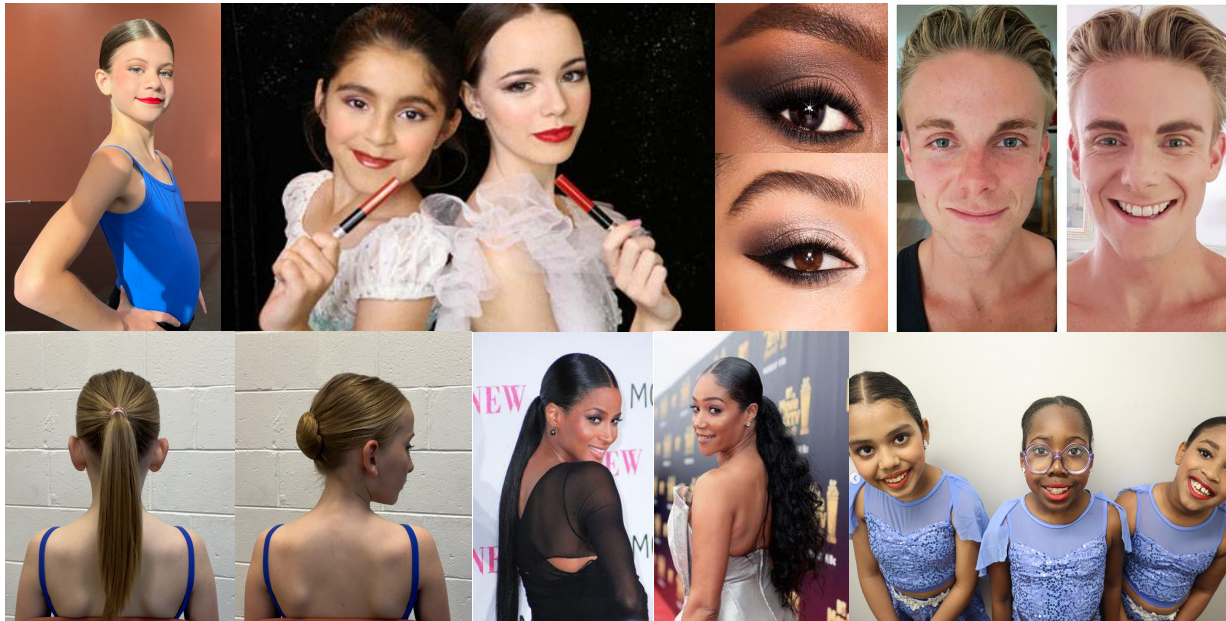

Recommended Stage Makeup Masc Look: Standard stage makeup is foundation, brown eyeshadow in the crease of the eye only, mascara, nude blush, nude lipstick.

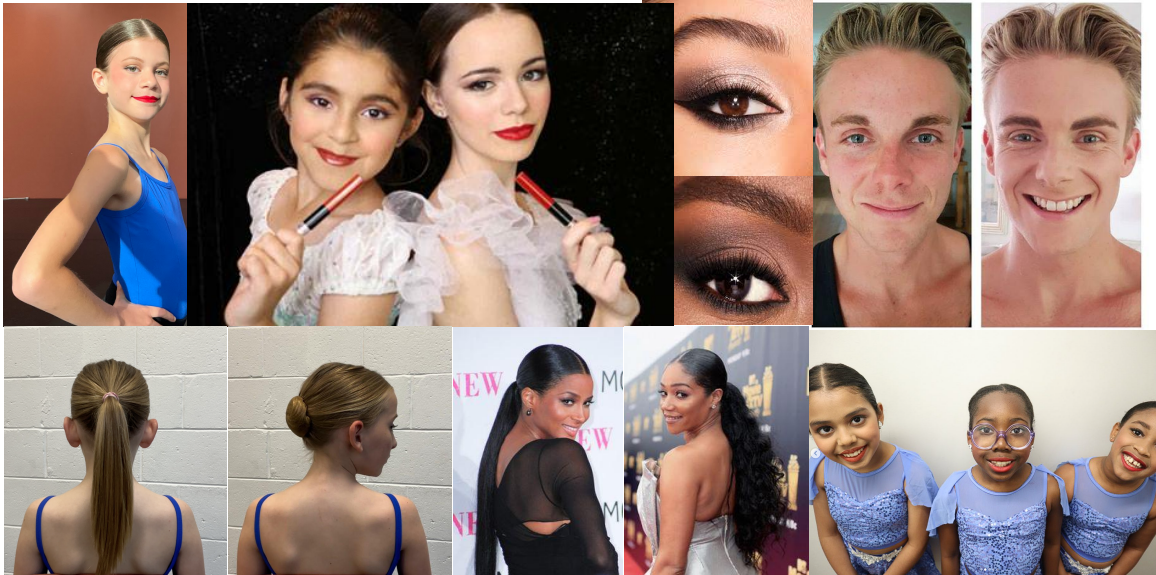
Femme Makeup Application: Grade 7 to 12

Base: Apply on a freshly washed face, both liquid foundation and powder
Primer (or setting spray) is optional and helps the makeup last longer

Eyes: White or cream eyeshadow can be used to highlight the eye close to the lashes and the brow bone under the eyebrow
Brown eyeshadow on the eyelid, blended up to the crease
Black liner on the upper lash line
Black mascara
Option to add a white or gold eyeshadow to inner corners of the eye and underneath for shimmer and intensity
Option to define the eyebrows with a brow liner
Option to add black false eyelashes such as Ardell 455

Cheeks: Light to medium pink, rose, or nude
Start at the hairline and sweep forward under cheek bone and swirl upward over apples
Blend upwards to make sure the blush does not go lower than the lip line on the cheek

Lips: Red colour avoiding orange undertones
Use a lip liner to outline lips, fill in the entire lip to keep student's lipstick on longer prior to applying lipstick
Apply lipstick
